

Reaching the un-reached and the least-reached.

The Southern Baptist International Mission Board charts at least 3,481 unengaged and un-reached people groups remaining in the world. There is a ratio within the work of missions that is seriously unbalanced. There are those who devote themselves to ministry and evangelism from established churches across the globe and there are those who go to the un-reached or least-reached peoples who have no church at all. Both types are necessary. But for every 100 of the first type there is only one who goes to the un-reached. It is our sincere desire to be intentional in our efforts to reach the un-reached, through the following ways:

A. Sending our own missionaries (both short term and long-term) to establish churches among the un-reached.

B. Supporting national pastors and missionaries who are reaching their own people (Gospel for Asia and Heart Cry Missionary Society)

C. Supporting the International Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention through the Cooperative Program.
